A) My Earth Model

- Take a soft ball of medium size.
- Cover it with blue and green paper, using tear and paste technique.
- Cut 5 circles from any light coloured pastel sheet.
- Draw, colour and name any 5 living things found on the earth on these circles.
- Using double sided tape, put these circles on your Earth model neatly
- Make a hanging type to present your earth model.



B) Puppet Craft

- Make two stick puppets of your favourite animals/birds/insects

- Colour your picture and paste it on a thick sheet.
- Make a cut out and glue or tape a craft stick or drinking straw at the back of each paper animal. Once the glue dries, your stick puppets are ready.

A) Ocean in a Bottle

- Take any used household transparent plastic jar or bottle (1 litre). Remove label from the bottle. Wash and clean it properly.
- Fill the bottle half with tap water.
- Add 3 to 4 drops of blue food colour and swirl gently to mix,
- Using funnel add glitter and sand (preferably grey /white in colour)
- Add coloured stones and shells ,small plastic fish of different types.
- Add vegetable oil (refined) until almost full. Leave small space for air at the top.
- Put glue around the rim of the bottle and seal the cap.
- Once glue is dry, turn the bottle on the side .Rock it back and forth to make your own ocean wave.

B) Sources of Water Dice for kids

A) Windsock craft

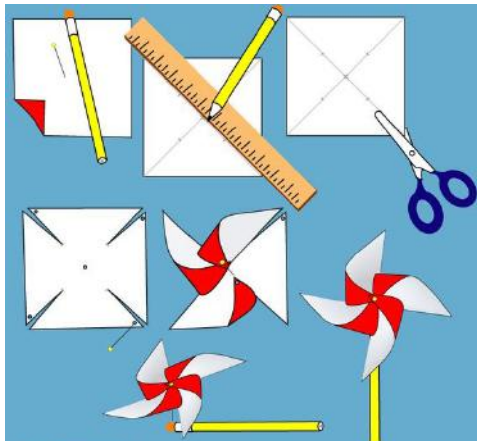
- Make your own windsock using cartridge sheet and colourful birthday streamers or crepe paper cuttings
- Decorate a regular cartridge sheet
- You can make a picture or pattern or paste some cutouts.
- Once it is decorated pull the short ends together and tape to make a cylinder.
- Using a hole punch make two holes on opposite sides of the cylinder.
- Now weave a ribbon into each hole to make a handle to hang the windsock craft. You now have lanterns.
- Now using crepe paper/ streamers tape one end on the **inside** of the lantern. Leave about " of a tail and cut.

B) Whirly Pinwheel

A) Wind Chime

Make a sun ,moon,star themed wind chime using soft balls or



cutouts. Make it more sparkly using glitters

B)Star Gazing Discovery Bottle

Things to be taken:

- Plastic Bottle
- Baby Oil
- Silver Glitter
- Silver stars
- Purple and Blue Liquid Food Colouring
- water



Instructions

1. Take a plastic water bottle. Remove the label from the water bottle.
2. Fill the bottle half full with baby oil.
3. Add silver glitter on top of the baby oil (About $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon of glitter)
4. Add enough water to a measuring cup to fill the rest of the bottle, then add approximately 8 drops of purple food colouring and 5 drops of blue food colouring. The more food colouring you add, the more opaque your galaxy will be. Add the silver stars too
5. Mix the water and pour it into the bottle, leaving about $\frac{3}{4}$ " of air space in the mouth section of the bottle.
6. Screw the lid back onto the bottle. You can seal it closed with tape or glue if you like.
7. Shake the bottle vigorously and watch the glitter move up as it settles

A) Recycle Rocket Craft

- All you will need is a toilet paper tube or a cardboard roll, orange/yellow construction paper, aluminum foil, scissors, and glue.
- Start by gluing a piece of orange paper around the toilet paper roll. You can also paint it (that's more fun but takes longer!)
- Then cut a circle out of yellow paper and cut one slit to the middle. Cut two strips of tin-foil and glue them on the bottom of the rocket.
- Then cut a yellow triangle wider than the toilet paper roll. Cut two slits on the bottom of the toilet paper tube across from each other. The yellow paper will just slide into them. After that it should be able to stand up by itself.
- Then cut out three small aluminum foil circles and glue them towards the top. Paste passport size (cut into round shape) pictures of your family on these circles.
- Take the yellow circle and roll it into a cone, gluing it secure. The trickiest part about this rocket project is getting the top to stay on. You will need a lot of glue or tape! There you have a cool rocket ship to launch, you can also add red tissue paper out the end to make it look like it's flying as well.
