26th Nov 2018

1. (a) ONLINE PUZZLE

- It is an individual activity (4 students from each section)
- Students will solve an online puzzle
- Preliminary round will be on 20.11.2018

1. (b) DOT-O-MANIA

- It is an individual event
- Children will be provided with dotted sheets. They will join the dots to create tessellation designs / geometrical patterns and colour the same.
- Material Required- scale, pencil colours/crayons, sketch pens for outlining
- Judgment Criteria- concept, presentation and neatness
- Time Limit – 1½ hours

Note- Students participating in ONLINE PUZZLE will not take part in DOT-O-MANIA.

2. KAARYSHALA

- To encourage learning while doing a workshop will be conducted by teachers on varied topics from Arts and Crafts to the dance moves and music.
- Material Required: Origami Sheets and Clay.

27th Nov 2018

1.(a) DECLAMATION

- It is an individual activity (4 students from each section)
- Students will speak on any one of the given topics-
- My Imaginary Friend.
- If I had a choice between getting money or becoming famous, I would choose...
- Duration- 2-3 minutes
- Judgment criteria- Focus on the Topic, Fluency and Presentation
- Preliminary round will be on 22.11.2018

1. (b) LITERARY STAMP

- It is an individual activity.
- Students will design a stamp related to any author. They can use that particular author's work or any famous quote from their work.
- The stamp should look like a stamp and should have all the necessary aspects.
- Judgment criteria: neatness, uniqueness and creativity
- Duration: 1 ½ hour

- Students will be taken to a park for picnic
- Learning outside the realms of the classrooms
- Time duration- School hours

28th Nov 2018

1. SCIENCE SCULPTURE

- It is an individual activity.
- Students will create 3D model (sculpture) based on any specific concept / law/ phenomenon/ process/ plant/ animal/ insect etc. (No working model is allowed)

- Material required- Any recyclable waste material and other required material
- Judgment Criteria- Innovation, Creativity, and Presentation
- Duration- 1½ hour

- It is an individual activity
- Students will make a 3D model to show any one Hindi grammatical topic like sangya, kriya, vilom shabad or any other topic of their choice.
- Material required- All the required material to make a 3D model, pictures related to the topic, fevicol, colours, cardboard etc.
